
HOME EDUCATION

-POLICY-

The School Act requires that parents must register home school learners by September 30th. Parents may register home school learners at a public school, an independent school, a francophone school or a distance learning school.

-REGULATION-

1. Service(s) that schools will offer home school learners on request:
 - a) Educational advice.
 - b) Evaluation and assessment services (sufficient to determine that education progress achieved by the student in relation to similar age and ability).
 - c) The loan of educational resource materials that is authorized and recommended.

 2. When a parent of a home school learner wishes to enroll their son/daughter in a school program or specific course they are subject to the following terms:
 - a) The Principal of that school will determine if space and resources are available.
 - b) The Principal of that school will determine the appropriate placement of the student.
 - c) Expectation will be that the student follows the school Code of Conduct.
 - d) At the elementary school level, a student may be registered only for a course which is a completely separate unit and not part of an integrated course.
Examples of completely separate courses are Band and French as a Second Language.
 - e) At the secondary level, a student will be required to pay the same fee(s) as full-time students. Such fees must be paid in full at the time of registration.
 - f) A student, whether or not he or she is registered in a school based course, will not be entitled to support services such as learning assistance and speech/language therapy.
