# **Economic Stability Dividend**

The Secretary Treasurer noted that the Pincial Government has advised at the BC economy grew by 3.2% in 20,1 which exceeded the forecast of 2.3%. This translates into a wage increase of 0.45% for BCTF and CUPE employees in School District No. 58 effective May 1, 2016.

## MSP Rate Increase
