

## POLICY 1.20 BOARD AUTHORITY AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Board of Education's authority is established within achievement

The Board provides effective governance of the school district, and fulfills this role, in part through the development and implementation of a strategic plan that establishes a vision, mission and goals that directs resources and aligns the work of staff.

The Board is committed to Truth and Reconciliation within the two traditional territories of Nicola and Syilx people and the development of goals, priorities, and measurable outcomes to carry out this responsibility.

The Board has a foundational responsibility to competently safeguard the interests, integrity and credibility of the district, to ensure its financial viability and to act in accordance with applicable laws, regulations and policies.

The Board exercises its authority and responsibilities through the development of policies and long-

6. To develop policy and bylaws which support its vision, mission, core values and operational priorities that will provide a framework within which the Superintendent can discharge their duties.
7. To monitor outcomes through reporting from staff through the Superintendent.
